

## NEW MOVES AT GLOBAL TIGER PATROL

After 12 years as wild tiger charity Global Tiger Patrol's Chair of Trustees, Amanda Bright recently stood down, whilst remaining as a trustee.

Jonathan Hodrien has taken over as Chairman and with it the day-to-day running of the charity. Having studied ecology at university, Jonathan has returned to university life, as he currently works at the University of Surrey developing environmental technologies. Formerly, he ran another international wildlife charity, Friends of Conservation. He saw his first tiger at Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve and has visited many tiger parks across India.

"Amanda Bright, and GTP founder Peter Lawton before her, have both set up Global Tiger Patrol with its own strengths, not least the invaluable support it receives from key experts in the field and the many supporters in the UK and elsewhere," said Jonathan Hodrien. "Moving forward, my main objectives are to ensure we raise money for the right projects, getting support to the people and communities who can influence the survival of the tiger in the wild. With 2010 being the Year of the Tiger and Global Tiger Patrol's 21<sup>st</sup> birthday, we are working on plans to capitalise on this unique situation next year. Time is crucial for the survival of the tiger in the wild and all that relies on the health of the environment in which it lives."

With Jonathan Hodrien now at the helm, the charity returns to Surrey.
